# What are Caravans & Campervans

---

**Caravans** are defined as 'any enclosed trailer designed primarily for human occupation whilst stationary' (Vehicle Standard (Australian Design Rule – Definitions and Vehicle Categories) 2005 (Cth)).

**Campervans** defined by the Australian Bureau of Statistics are self-propelled motor vehicles containing an area primarily used for accommodation. This definition would include vehicles commonly referred to as motorhomes.
